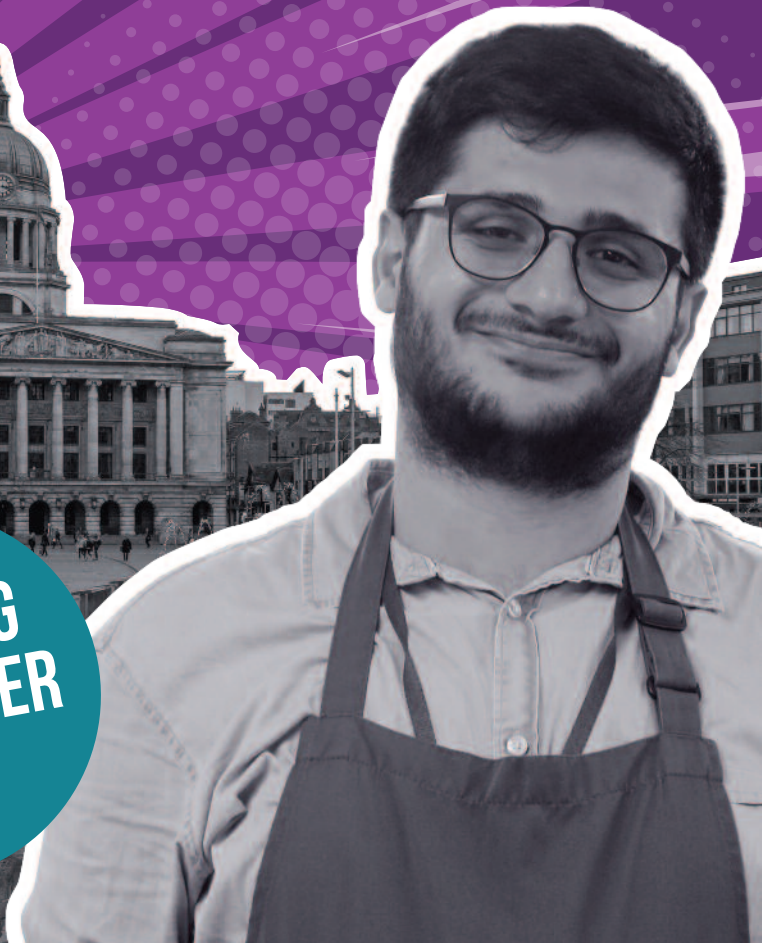

### WHO'S IT FOR?

This programme is perfect if you want to improve your health and well-being by learning outdoors, while gaining lots of independence skills. You will need to be aged 18-24 and have an Education Health and Care Plan to apply.

### WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

Based at the stunning Wollaton Park in our brand-new training centre, you'll learn a wide range of practical skills including:

- **Horticulture** - how to plant, look after and harvest a range of produce.
- **Vocational skills** - grounds maintenance and entry level trade skills.

Your programme will be tailored around the outcomes in your Education, Health and Care Plan. This means, we might help you focus on developing your personal skills, or you might choose to study a related qualification up to Level 2.

## WHEN WILL I BE AT COLLEGE?

This programme starts in September 2022. You'll spend 3 days a week at college at our Wollaton Park site. A typical week could be:

**Day 1** - Tutorials covering Preparation for Adulthood skills.

**Day 2** - Improving your English and Maths (if appropriate, you could do GCSE or Functional Skills).

**Day 3** - Vocation Day - developing your practical skills in Horticulture, Grounds Maintenance and Trade Skills.

Your programme will usually last between 1 and 2 years.

## WHAT'S NEXT?

When you've finished your programme, you might progress into a second year at Wollaton Park, move into mainstream education or choose to look for paid or voluntary employment.

Your Tutor and our Information, Advice, Guidance and Transition Team (IAGT) will help you make your decision.



# Employability Programme @ ANTENNA

## WHO'S IT FOR?

This programme is perfect if you want to focus on preparing for employment. You will need to be aged 18-24 and have an Education Health and Care Plan to apply.



## WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

Based at Confetti, in the fabulous city centre Antenna Building, your programme will be focussed around the employability outcomes in your Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP).

You'll gain lots of employability skills including:

- Communication in the workplace
- Team building
- Health and safety
- Searching and applying for jobs
- CV writing and interview techniques

You'll also be able to try out different work placements until you find something you're interested in.

We are ideally located to support employment opportunities in retail, hospitality and catering and facilities management.



## WHEN WILL I BE AT COLLEGE?

This programme starts in September 2022. You'll spend 3 days a week at college at our Antenna site. A typical week could be:

**Day 1** - Tutorials covering Preparation for Adulthood skills

**Day 2** - Improving your English and Maths (if appropriate, you could do GCSE or Functional Skills)

**Day 3** - Vocation Day - developing your employability skills and attending work placements.

Your programme will usually last between 1 and 2 years.
